Prof. Rawat welcomed external experts and all other members in the seventh Research Committee meeting. He addressed the gathering with his expert views. He pointed out that university should promote interdisciplinary research as per new education policy so that innovative cause may be generated. He directed all Deans to emphasize on quality research publications and books writing in view of forth coming NAAC inspection of the university. Multi layering cropping system, use of biofertilizer & bio-fencing techniques should be promoted by the School of Agriculture Sciences. Prof. Rawat directed Dean Research to keep in touch with latest regulation of statuary bodies like UGC, PCI, MCI & INC for any research related update. Dr. Arun Kumar (Dean-Research) welcomed all directions given by honorable Vice Chancellor and ensured that these will be kept in mind.

The following agenda items were discussed in the meeting:

Agenda 1 & 2: To consider confirmation of minutes of 6th Research Committee meeting held on 16/05/2020 & action taken report.

All members were informed that the Minutes of the meeting of Research Committee of Shri Guru Ram Rai University, held on 16th May 2020, have been duly circulated to all via email on 21/05/2020 & 11/01/2021 and no inputs/suggestions were received. Dr. Arun Kumar again presented the gist of the proceedings of the 6th Research Committee meeting along with the follow up action in front of all honorable members of research committee.

Prof. Dwarika Prasad Maithani raised query upon the credit score and marks allotment of Pre Ph.D course work and suggested that there should be 100 marks for each paper, Matter was thoroughly discussed in front of all members. Dean Research presented latest UGC regulation and some other university examples in the same line and said that there is no relation between credit score and marks. It was informed that university official prepared Pre Ph.D course work structure after doing hard work and reviewing many universities research ordinances as well as latest UGC regulations 2018. He told that research scholar has to qualify minimum of 10 credit and maximum 18 credit score with 55% in general category and 50% for SC, ST OBC (non creamy layer). Prof. J.P Bhatt said that present structure of Pre Ph.D course work of Shri Guru Ram Rai University is alright. Marks are just for calculating percentage only. Prof. Anil Mehta, Prof. Amit Verma, Prof. M.S. Kandpal, Prof. Manoj Gahlot and Prof. Deepak Sahni seconded this and all other members agreed upon it. All the members reviewed the minutes thoroughly and expressed satisfaction on rest of the follow up action initiated by Dean-Research.

Resolution: The minutes of 6thResearch Committee Meeting and follow up action were unanimously confirmed by the house.

Prof. Kumud Saklani told that e-library with e-content should be developed for research scholars as we are taking library fee from the scholars so part of that fund may be fixed for new research journals and books. Prof. Deepak Sahni, Prof. Amit Verma, Prof. Kirtima Upadhayay and Prof. M.S. Kandpal agreed on it. Dean Research invited inputs from external experts, Prof. Bhatt suggested that central research laboratories should be developed and initially two good research journals may be procured schools wise. He also suggested that this matter might be placed in BOG meeting for approval.

Resolution: It was resolved to approve that matter will be placed in next Academic Council and Board of Governor (BOG) meetings for further discussion.
