- 5. Consultancy (20).

Prof. J.P. Bhatt suggested that there should be a research and development policy for the faculty members of the university also in view of NAAC criterion so all faculties may get motivated, Prof. S.S Rawat Prof. Kumud Saklani and all other supported his views. Dr. Arun Kumar placed "Research & Development Seed Money Policy" for the faculty members and said Shri Guru Ram Rai University provides the financial support to Research Projects of faculty members of different Departments and Schools. University promotes the research-based education in emerging area in applied sciences, humanities, education, medical, Computer Science, management and agricultural sciences (**Annexure-I**). Research Committee approved 50,000/- seed money for Sciences subjects & 25000/- for Humanities, Management, Computer science & Education etc for two faculty members per School per year. Prof. U.S Rawat suggested that this matter might be placed in BOG meeting for approval.

Dean-Research also placed Innovation & Incubation Centre (IIC) policy before the house members as prepared by Dr. Pankaj Chamoli. It is a platform to nurtur and

encourag the entrepreneurial spirit of start-up enthusiasts in a healthy bio-network to promote their ideas, start-ups and researches. This venture will provide a space for young and beautiful minds to transform their ground-breaking ideas into a viable business proposition (Annexure-II).

Shri Guru Ram Rai University is committed to the highest ethical values and standards in conducting of any research project/ research schemes/dissertations/publication of research papers, book and book chapter/ thesis writing/ patents/others. Dean-Research informed house that we are carrying the upgraded research works with adequate novelty. The main objective of this policy is to aware all research scholars and supervisors about moral responsibilities to research ethics (**Annexure-III**).

Dr. Arun Kumar placed "Research Consultancy policy" for the university. Prof. J.P. Bhatt appreciated this policy and advised that a letter should be drafted with the consultation of honorable Vice Chancellor and sent it to all companies working in the same area in Uttarakhand region so that they might avail our expert advice and pay us (Annexure-IV).

Resolution: All members agreed on it and resolved to approve with a note that matter will be placed in next Academic Council and Board of Governor (BOG) meetings for further discussion.

Agenda 6: Reporting items:

1. Report on current status of available/assigned Ph.D. seats in university.

Dr. Arun Kumar informed the members of the house that the university has created 506 seats in 41 specializations available at the nine schools of university, 386 seats have been filled till date.

All members reviewed the status of the seats for their respective School and appreciated the same. Dr. Arun Kumar invited suggestions on the point where existing supervisors have resigned from their posts then who will be the supervisor for the Ph.D scholars allotted to them. Prof. J.P. Bhatt, and Prof. S. S. Rawat suggested that there should be a buffer zone of 25% Ph.D seats in each department. Dr. Kumud Saklani, Dr. Amit Verma, Dr. Parul Goyal & Dr. M.S. Kandpal also suggested not taking admissions of Ph.D scholars in full capacity of the respective department. Dr. Deepak Sahni Also said that it may not be a seat filling programme, it is very specialized & should be taken utmost care while seats filling of each discipline. Dean-Research ensured the members that the matter will be put before Honorable Vice Chancellor sir via Academic Council meeting for further directions.
